**SUBJECT: 9-1-1 ALS PROVIDER RESPONSE POLICY**

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## **I. PURPOSE**

- A. 9-1-1 Advanced Life Support (ALS) providers perform the vital and important service of providing definitive prehospital emergency medical care in our communities. This policy is to ensure that all requests for pre-hospital emergency care shall be responded to by on duty ALS staff and a response vehicle.

## **II. AUTHORITY**

- A. California Health and Safety Code, Division 2.5, Sections 1797.200, 1797.201, 1797.204, 1797.206, 1797.220, 1797.224, 1797.252, and 1798.
- B. California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Sections 100147, 100167, and 100169.

## **III. POLICY**

- A. Each 9-1-1 ALS Service provider shall have policies and procedures in place to require on duty EMS personnel to respond, when dispatched, to all requests for medical aid.
- B. Each 9-1-1 ALS provider shall submit the above referenced policies and procedures to S-SV EMS Agency for review.
- C. Any violation of the ALS provider policies shall be reported to S-SV EMS.
