2.	<ul> <li>States Contraindications</li> <li>Age &lt; 3 yrs or estimated weight &lt; 15 kg</li> <li>Conscious patient</li> <li>Moving ambulance</li> <li>Pt has midline neck hematoma or massive subcutaneous emphysema</li> </ul>		
3.	States or demonstrates the use of appropriate PPE		
4.	<ul> <li>Checks / prepares equipment</li> <li>12 or 14 gage over-the-needle catheter with 10 ml syringe attached</li> <li>Jet Insufflation Device or ENK Flow Modulator properly connected to an oxygen source</li> </ul>		
5.	Stabilizes the larynx using the thumb and middle finger of one hand		
6.	Uses the other hand to locate the correct insertion site – cricothyroid membrane		
7.	Inserts the needle downward through the midline of the membrane at a $45-60$ degree angle toward the patients carina while applying negative pressure to the syringe during insertion		
8.	Verifies that the needle has entered the trachea by the ability to aspirate air into the syringe		
9.	Advances the catheter over the needle toward the carina. Removes and		

properly disposes of the needle and syringe
