**Every year**, millions of people in our country and around the world are forced or coerced into labor or commercial sex acts in a practice known as human trafficking. This form of modern slavery has spawned a billion-dollar illegal industry.

Sex trafficking in Shasta County takes place in a variety of forms and locations - illicit massage parlors, motel/apartment brothers, and at truck stops along the I-5 corridor. Drug abuse, unstable home environments, high regional ACE scores, poverty and lack of life opportunity are some of the factors providing opportunities for this behavior in our community.
