Course Overview:

This course is the Hybrid course that offers 8 hours of cognitive materials on-line and 8 hours of in-person learning. The on-line portion must be completed, and a proof of completion brought for admittance to the in-person class. This is an advanced-level course, it is the responsibility of the student to prepare for the course with pre-reading and to be ready for a fast-paced agenda.

Course Description:

The PHTLS course provides prehospital care providers with specific knowledge and skills related to the assessment and care, increasing the probability of a person surviving a traumatic event. This course is scenario based with lectures and interactive skills that are designed to impart knowledge and proficiency. Target audience for this course is the Paramedic level.
