

Prehospital Trauma Life Support (PHTLS)



OVERVIEW

Prehospital Trauma Life Support is a paramedic-level hybrid course that is scenario based with lectures and interactive skills that are designed to impart knowledge and proficiency. It provides prehospital care providers with specific knowledge and skills related to assessment and care, increasing the probability of a person surviving a traumatic event.

CEs are provided by the National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT) upon successful course completion.

STYLE

PHTLS includes 8 hours of online cognitive materials and 8 hours of in-person learning.

You will be practicing skills that require you to work on your hands and knees. The course requires bending, standing and lifting.

If you have a physical condition that might prevent you from engaging in these activities, please tell the instructor before the class begins. The instructor may be able to adjust the equipment to make a reasonable accommodation.
