

Adapted from the Advanced Life Support in Obstetrics (ALSO) program, the **Basic Life Support in Obstetrics (BLSO)** curriculum teaches basic delivering skills, as well as stabilizing tactics for obstetric emergencies. The course meets the unique needs of first responders, ER staff, students, nurses, non-delivering physicians, and other professionals who may engage with pregnant individuals.



Overall Course Objectives

Detailed educational objectives are listed at the beginning of each BLSO chapter

1. Discuss methods of managing pregnancy, birth urgencies, and emergencies, which standardizes the skills of practicing pregnancy care providers.
2. Demonstrate content and skill acquisition as evidenced by successful completion of course examination, skills workstations, and testing.
3. Demonstrate effective team communication strategies that focus on patient safety.

- 8-hour mandatory self-study online course due 24 hours before live course.

 - Topics include: Normal Labor and Initial Assessment ▪ Trauma & Resuscitation in Pregnancy ▪ Malpresentations-Breech ▪ Postpartum Hemorrhage/EBL ▪ Shoulder Dystocia ▪ Case Studies (Hypertensive Emergencies and Preterm Labor)
